St. Mary Parish was established in 1795 and is the oldest Catholic parish in the Commonwealth of Virginia. To fund the building of the church, Colonel John Fitzgerald, friend of George Washington and an early mayor of Alexandria, took up a collection. According to local tradition, Washington himself made the first donation. A chapel was built at the south end of the city, on land presently used as St. Mary’s Cemetery located at 1000 South Royal Street. St. Mary’s has an active Society of St. Vincent de Paul Conference.
