Helping Individuals with Social Security Disability Insurance and Return to Work

To qualify for SSDI, an individual must:

- Be between 21 and full retirement age
- Have worked 5 of the last 10 years
- Be currently unable to work and expected to be unable to work for 12 months or longer

If the individual is **not working**, refer to **SVDP.Allsup.com** or log on to the site with the individual.

The individual who is **not working** completes the Free online Allsup SSDI Assessment on their own or with your assistance.

Completing the SSDI process with Allsup greatly increases your chances of receiving benefits.

Individuals earning more than \$1,170 per month are not eligible for SSDI benefits.

If the individual is working part time and earning less than \$1,170 per month,
